

ERIC'S RX SHOPPE FAQ — COVID-19 VACCINE 2025–2026

Does Eric's have the newest COVID-19 vaccine?

Yes. We currently stock mNEXSPIKE by Moderna, the latest COVID-19 vaccine available for the 2025–2026 season.

When can I get the COVID-19 vaccine?

Now, as long as it has been a minimum of 3 months since your last COVID-19 vaccine.

Is the new COVID-19 vaccine covered by Medicare and other Insurers?

Yes. Medicare Part B covers the cost of the vaccine. Based off conversations we have had, we are confident that other insurers will continue to provide coverage for the COVID-19 vaccines through this respiratory season.

Do I need an appointment?

No appointment is required. Walk-ins are welcome. However, if you choose to schedule an appointment you can do so online at www.ericssrx.com.

What is different about the new COVID-19 vaccine (mNEXSPIKE) compared to the old one?

mNEXSPIKE is a next-generation vaccine from Moderna designed to:

- Provide broader protection against the newest circulating COVID strains.
- Offer enhanced effectiveness with fewer side effects.

Am I eligible to receive the vaccine?

Yes, if you meet one of the following:

- Have a previous history of receiving a COVID-19 vaccine (in order to receive mNEXSPIKE) **AND**
- Age 65 and older **OR**
- Age 12–64 with at least one underlying medical condition that places you at higher risk for severe COVID-19 outcomes. Please see full list at www.ericssrx.com/conditions

Will I need to prove that I have an underlying medical condition?

No. There is a self-attestation on our form in which you would check how you qualify.

Do I need a prescription to receive the COVID vaccine?

If you don't attest that you meet the criteria in which the vaccine is indicated for (65+ or underlying medical condition), you would need to have a prescription from your provider for us to administer the vaccine to you. This policy may change as we receive further guidance from our regulatory bodies.

When will Eric's offer COVID-19 vaccines for ages 3-11?

At present time, the pediatric COVID-19 vaccine from Moderna is not commercially available. We anticipate shipments arriving sometime around the middle of September.

Can I get the COVID-19 on the same day as my Flu Vaccine?

Yes, co-administration of the Flu and COVID-19 vaccine is safe and recommended by many federal agencies and physician groups.

- Bring your Medicare card or insurance information.
- Keep track of your last vaccine date to ensure eligibility.
